Grand Opening of West 17th Street Clinic to Commemorate World AIDS Day

November 22, 2011 - On Thursday, December 1st at 5:30pm, St. Luke's and Roosevelt Hospitals' Center for Comprehensive Care (CCC) will host a grand opening of their West 17th Street Clinic. This all inclusive clinic provides HIV primary care, psychotherapy, case management, dental care and a full range of specialty services including dermatology, cardiology, ob-gyn, and an on-site pharmacy. It operates on a "medical home" model where patients stay in one room while doctors, nurses and other caregivers come to their room in turn, tipped off by a multi-colored flag system above each door and overseen by a Flow Coordinator who ensures each patient's visit is smooth and efficient with minimal waiting time.

The grand opening event will include a program that will begin at 6:15 and will feature remarks by Dr. Monica Sweeney, Assistant Commissioner for the Bureau of HIV/AIDS Prevention and Control, Gail Donovan, Executive Vice President, Chief Operating Officer at Continuum Health Partners and Director of the Center for Comprehensive Care Dr. Victoria Sharp.

Before and after the remarks, CCC will conduct tours of the new facility, where guests will meet the staff and learn about the site and CCC.

The grand opening takes place on World AIDS Day, a global health day dedicated to people worldwide uniting in the fight against HIV, showing their support for people living with HIV and commemorating people who have died.
